

### **Publication Ethics Policy of WIJBAS:**

Ethical criteria for publication exist to ensure reliable & high-quality scientific research, publications, public faith in scientific findings, and that researchers receive recognition for their work & ideas. WIJBAS follows a rigorous Code of Conduct and aims to adhere to its Best Practice Guidelines.

- **Plagiarism:** All articles published by WIJBAS are committed to publishing only original material, i.e., stuff that has neither been brought out elsewhere, nor is under review elsewhere. Manuscripts that are found to be plagiarized from a manuscript by other writers, whether published or unpublished, will incur plagiarism penalty.
- **Duplicate Submission:** Manuscripts that are found to have been published elsewhere, or to be under review elsewhere, will incur duplicate submission sanctions. If authors have practiced their own previously published work, or work that is currently under review, as the ground of a submitted manuscript, they are asked to cite the former study and suggest how their submitted manuscript offers novel contributions beyond those of the late study.

**Improper Author Contribution or Attribution:** All listed authors must have reached a significant scientific contribution to the inquiry in the manuscript and approved all its titles. It is important to list everyone who gained a significant scientific contribution, including students and lab technicians.

- **Redundant Publications:** Redundant publications involve the inappropriate division of study outcomes into several articles.
- **Citation Manipulation:** Submitted manuscripts that are set up to include citations whose primary aim is to increase the number of references to a given author's work, or to articles printed in a particular journal, will incur citation manipulation penalty.
- **Data Fabrication & Falsification:** Submitted manuscripts that are set up to have either made up or falsified experimental results, including the handling of images, will incur data fabrication and falsification penalty.
- **Penalty:** In the event that there are documented violations of any of the above mentioned policies of WIJBAS, regardless of whether or not the assaults occurred in a journal published by WIJBAS, the following regulations will be enforced:
  - Immediate rejection of the infringing manuscript.
  - Immediate rejection of every other manuscript submitted to any journal published by WIJBAS by any of the writers of the infringing manuscript.
  - Prohibition against all of the authors for any new submissions to WIJBAS, either singly or in compounding with other sources of the infringing manuscript, as easily as in combination with any other sources. This prohibition will be levied for a lower limit of 2 years.
  - Prohibition against all of the authors from serving on the Editorial Board of WIJBAS.
  - In instances where the infringements of the above policies are found to be particularly offensive/flagrant, the publisher reserves the right to impose additional restrictions beyond those identified above.
